

A track record of success

Over the last 45 years Scenic Hudson has been a force for large-scale conservation in the valley, protecting more than 25,000 acres of iconic vistas, habitat-rich forests and wetlands, and working farmland. At the same time we've created or enhanced 40 parks and preserves stretching from Westchester and Rockland counties to the Capital Region.

Our visionary plan for the valley's future

Despite the current real estate market, the Hudson Valley faces an ever-growing tide of development pressure. Recognizing that we are the stewards for what is truly an irreplaceable national treasure, Scenic Hudson has launched an essential plan to **Save the Land That Matters Most**.

Engaging key state and local leaders, and employing the latest mapping techniques, Scenic Hudson experts pinpointed 65,000 acres of the highest scenic, ecological and agricultural significance. To conserve these critical landscapes—the most ambitious land-protection initiative in Hudson Valley history—we've forged strong partnerships with local, regional and national land trusts as well as governments, businesses and individuals.

Our land trust partners also deliver experience, results

Recognizing that the success of our ambitious plan to Save the Land That Matters Most requires strong partnerships, Scenic Hudson is collaborating with 16 land trusts and conservation organizations with superb track records. University Settlement Camp

City of Beacon, 91 acres

Facilitated purchase by NYS Office of Parks, Recreation and Historic Preservation of camp with fields and wooded slopes on Mount Beacon. Also acquired five acres on Fishkill Creek, aiding creation of shoreline trail.



Black Creek Corridor*

Town of Lloyd, 82 acres


Protects 4,200 feet of shoreline and critical wildlife habitats within vernal pools, hardwood swamps and hemlock forest.



Davenport Farm*

Town of Marbletown, 325 acres

Ensures farm's prized soils continue yielding produce sold throughout the region. Protected in collaboration with Open Space Institute, NYS Department of Agriculture & Markets and Ulster County.





Brooks Farm*

Town of Marbletown, 45 acres

Made possible launch of new dairy operation. Protected in collaboration with NYS Department of Agriculture & Markets, Open Space Institute and Ulster County.



Hyde Park Trail Buffer

Town of Hyde Park, 48 acres

Protects carriage road passing through rolling woodland. Provides key buffer for part of 10-mile trail linking popular historic sites.




Dominican Camp

Town of Hyde Park, 72 acres

Preserves scenic gateway to town's historic sites, views from Scenic Hudson's Black Creek Preserve, wetland habitats. Creates vital link in Hyde Park Trail; offers sweeping Hudson River views, potential river access.

This year we went into overdrive, completing 27 percent more transactions—and conserving 34 percent more acres—than last year.



Black Creek Corridor Town of Esopus, 167 acres

Protects nearly a mile of Black Creek shoreline, stunning waterfalls, rock ledges and intact forest. Located between Black Creek Preserve and John Burroughs Sanctuary.



Red Hook Farmland*

Town of Red Hook, 224 acres

Partnered with town to preserve four contiguous farm properties. Increases to 1,900 acres town farmland conserved with Dutchess Land Conservancy, Winnakee Land Trust and local and county governments.



Stonington Farm*

Town of Clermont, 232 acres

Brings to 522 acres the "critical mass" of working farms we've protected in town dependent on agriculture-based economy.



Mount Merino

Town of Greenport, 102 acres

Increases to 1,250 acres scenic lands viewed from Olana we've safeguarded. Adds to 122 acres preserved on Mount Merino by Columbia Land Conservancy.

On the horizon even greater success

Building on this year's success—14 acquisitions encompassing 1,386 acres—our land-protection experts have set even more ambitious goals for FY 2009: 20 transactions safeguarding 2,200 acres.

Currently in the acquisition pipeline we have more than 30 properties requiring \$30 million to protect for future generations. These include publicly accessible Hudson River waterfronts, iconic vistas, working farms and wetlands supporting an astonishing variety of wildlife.

Already in FY 2009 we've protected 470 acres on two working farms as well as 117 ecologically diverse acres along the Hudson River in Columbia County. We have transactions pending in Putnam, Orange, Ulster, Greene, Columbia and Albany counties. At the same time, we're helping communities create new parks in Westchester, Rockland, Dutchess, Ulster and Albany counties.



We use our parks and preserves to connect people to the Hudson River through exciting events like our first-ever Movie Night at Foundry Dock Park in Cold Spring, Putnam County, and a kayak trip from Esopus Meadows Preserve in Esopus, Ulster County. This year in Beacon, Scenic Hudson educators introduced 500 schoolchildren to nature at our local parks.



We're working to guarantee a healthy, economically vibrant Hudson Valley

We stand up for the Hudson Valley in three ways—by making sure new development respects environmental needs, by bringing people to the river and by sharing our expertise.

WESTCHESTER COUNTY

At public hearings we urged citizens of **Yonkers** to speak out strongly against developers' plans to cover their waterfront with a virtual wall of high-rises, cutting off access to the river and marring views of the Palisades—the city's natural skyline.

In **Tarrytown** we're working with the village, county and a developer to complete designs for an exciting waterfront park that will replace an 80-year-old asphalt plant. In nearby **Sleepy Hollow**, we're turning the Kingsland Point Bathhouse into a center for river-related activities.

ORANGE COUNTY

As a member of the Port Authority's Citizens Advisory Panel for **Stewart Airport**, Senior Vice President Steve Rosenberg has led efforts to ensure the expanded facility will protect our natural and historic treasures and provide direct economic benefits to the City of Newburgh.

DUTCHESS COUNTY

Shortly after we released an ecological assessment of a proposed 951-unit development in **Pine Plains**—showing how the project would cause widespread harm to wildlife habitat—the developer announced it was revising plans substantially to respond to our concerns. But the devil's in the details, so we're working with local partner Pine Plains United to ensure the project fully meets the community's goals.

We provided a leadership grant to transform the 120-year-old **Poughkeepsie** Railroad Bridge into Walkway Over the Hudson, the world's longest elevated public park, which will link 30 miles of rail trails in Dutchess and Ulster counties.

ULSTER COUNTY

A Scenic Hudson study showed that the 1,750-unit Hudson Landing Project in **Kingston** would have unacceptable visual impacts from the Hudson River and Dutchess County, violating both state and local waterfront policies.

COLUMBIA COUNTY

In **Stockport** a new six-acre Scenic Hudson park soon will showcase panoramic views of the Hudson River and Catskills.

THROUGHOUT THE HUDSON VALLEY

We went all out to introduce people to our parks, hosting 48 events—160 percent more than in FY 2007. Activities ranged from a yoga class at Scenic Hudson Park in **Irvington**, Westchester County, to a dragonfly-discovery hike at Shaupeneak Ridge in **Esopus**, Ulster County.

We provided support to help five riverfront communities create new or improved waterfront parks as a lasting commemoration of the 2009 Quadricentennial. Ranging from two to 80 acres, the parks are in **Hastings-on-Hudson** and **Cortlandt** (Westchester), **Nyack** (Rockland), **Tivoli** (Dutchess) and **Bethlehem** (Albany).

And 80 percent of the recommendations in our recent comprehensive review of the NYS Department of State's Coastal Management Program—which oversees development along the river's shores—have already been adopted.





Financial Overview

Consolidated results for Scenic Hudson and The Scenic Hudson Land Trust for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2008, show program growth for the period. Total operating expenses were \$11.1 million, up 4.8 percent from \$10.6 million spent in FY 07.

Scenic Hudson

Operating expenses totaled \$5.7 million, an 8-percent increase over the prior year, and operating revenues totaled \$5.9 million, a 10-percent increase over the previous year. To accelerate protection of the Hudson Valley's vanishing landscapes and create new parks with public access to the river, the organization added seven professional staff positions during the year. As a result of this growth, we soon will be opening new parks in Westchester, Dutchess, Ulster and Columbia counties.

The Scenic Hudson Land Trust

Operating expenses totaled \$7.1 million, up 2 percent from the previous year, and included \$2.3 million to purchase conservation easements on eight properties protecting 805 acres. The properties comprise important farmland as well as land that contributes to the Hudson River Valley National Heritage Area. In addition the land trust purchased five properties protecting 478 acres for \$3.9 million. The purchase of two properties on the Hudson River was sponsored by Kathryn Wasserman Davis with funds from The Shelby Cullom Davis Foundation. The land trust conveyed five conservation properties along Fishkill Ridge and at Stockport Flats to New York State.

Financial Structure

Scenic Hudson maintains two endowments: The Lila Acheson and DeWitt Wallace Hudson Valley Land Preservation Endowment (\$145 million at year-end FY 08) used to support capital costs and expenses related to land acquisitions and conservation easements, and a board-designated fund for general operating expenses (\$7.9 million at year-end FY 08). The assets are pooled in a diversified portfolio supervised by an Investment Committee. Total investment return was -4.3 percent for FY 08. Investment returns annualized since inception were 8.4 percent versus the benchmark at 8 percent. The board sets a spending rate for the endowments; since FY 99, this has been 5 percent of the past 12 quarters' rolling average value. The board engages Marks Paneth & Shron, LLP, to perform an independent audit.

Although lands owned by the land trust are eligible for tax exemption, Scenic Hudson paid \$218,594 in property taxes and payments in lieu of taxes in FY 08 and \$258,931 in FY 07.
